The Northern Virginia 4-H Educational Center in Harmony Hollow, adjacent to the Shenandoah National Park and the Appalachian Trail, is only a few miles from Interstate 66 as well as Interstate 81. We offer many different programming opportunities such as Low and High Ropes Challenge Course, a 2-sided Climbing Tower, as well as Environmental Education and Outdoor Education. Along with those opportunities, we offer conferencing space and facilities for retreats. Our facility is open year-round at affordable prices. We offer a complete line of services including handicapped accessible heated lodging, dining service, wireless internet, meeting rooms, audio-visual equipment, and recreational facilities. We welcome mid-week and weekend business for conferences, seminars, retreats, and workshops.



Lodging

Robinson Lodge

This lodge has heat and air conditioning and features a large common area between its two wings complete with a wood burning fireplace, great for small meetings or social gatherings. Rooms are furnished with 3 sets of twin bunk beds (2 sets in handicap accessible rooms). Each room has a private bathroom.



Congressman Hall

This lodge has heat and air conditioning and features two common areas for social gatherings. Rooms are furnished with 2 sets of twin bunk beds. Each room has a private bathroom.

Peters and Rector Lodges

These two lodges were once the only buildings at the Northern Virginia 4-H Center and housed both the campers and the administrative offices. Both lodges have 3 sets of bunk beds in each room and shared bathrooms. If you're looking for a rustic retreat these lodges are perfect for you!



Lillie's Cottage

Previously the Directors Residence, this house is available to rent both by the room or as a whole house. With 4 bedrooms, 2 full bathrooms, 1 half bathroom and a shower room there is plenty of space for the whole family. There is a full kitchen, washer and dryer, fireplace and wrap around deck.

Programs

Challenge Course

The Northern Virginia 4-H Center's John E. Dooley Challenge Course Program is run as a sequence of activities and elements that are intended to serve as an experiential education tool to encourage teamwork, foster self-confidence and trust, and engage participants both physically and mentally. Additionally, the challenge course provides participants with an opportunity to reflect upon and recognize their role as a leader, follower, team member, and individual.

Our trained facilitators will meet your group where they are at--no need for prior experience. The success of the team depends on each member's willingness to work with and rely on each other for support. Members of your group need to be at least 9 years old.

Natural Resource & Outdoor Education

Whether your students need the benefits of team-building and enhanced communication, forest exploration and animal habitat study on the Appalachian Trail, or ornithology and macroinvertebrate studies, the 4-H Center will provide an appropriate, safe, and research-based program specifically designed for your students.

The 4-H Center offers many fun, hands-on learning experiences for children ages 5 and up. Our curriculum correlates with Virginia State SOL's and is flexible and accommodating. We offer single day or multi-day programs for both private and public schools and other youth groups. All of our programs are led and instructed by trained, caring professionals committed to the sharing of knowledge and the improvement of young people.

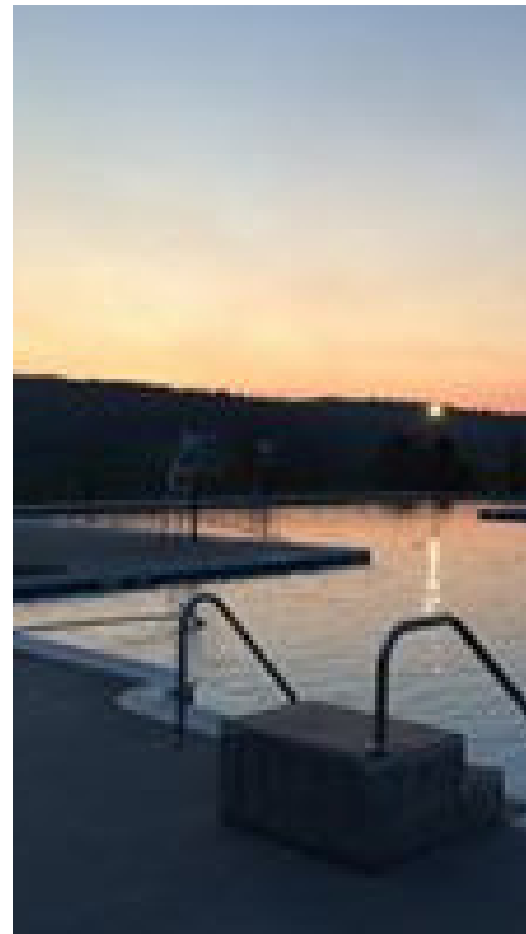

Located in scenic Harmony Hollow on the 4-H Center grounds, our pool is open to the public and offers a great place to enjoy a respite from the summer heat without crowds. A playground is conveniently placed right outside the front door, adjacent to the parking lot. We also offer swim lessons based on American Red Cross curriculum.
