



We offer a complete line of services including handicapped accessible heated lodging, dining service, wireless internet, meeting rooms, audio-visual equipment, and recreational facilities. Robinson Lodge

This lodge has heat and air conditioning and features a large common area between its two wings complete with a wood burning fireplace, great for small meetings or social gatherings. Rooms are furnished with 3 sets of twin bunk beds (2 sets in handicap accessible rooms). Each room has a private bathroom. Max capacity is 104 guests.



Congressman Hall

This lodge has heat and air conditioning and features two common areas for social gatherings. Rooms are furnished with 2 sets of twin bunk beds. Each room has a private bathroom. Max capacity is 96 guests


Peters and Rector Lodges

Both lodges have 3 sets of bunk beds in each room and shared bathrooms. If you're looking for a rustic retreat these lodges are perfect for you! Both lodges have heat and window unit air conditioning and large central lobby or flex meeting space. Peter's Lodge comes equipped with standard size kitchen, washer & dryer. Peter's Lodge max capacity is 66 guests and Rector's max capacity is 80.

Day Programs at NOVA 4-H Center

Whether your group needs the benefits of team-building and enhanced communication, or forest exploration on the Appalachian Trail the 4-H Center will provide an appropriate, safe, and research-based program specifically designed for you.

The 4-H Center offers many fun, hands-on learning experiences. Our curriculum correlates with Virginia State SOL's and is flexible and accommodating. We offer single day or multi-day programs for both private and public schools and other groups in addition to retreats and conferences. All of our programs are led and instructed by trained, caring professionals committed to the sharing of knowledge and the improvement of all. Program content and activities can be adjusted to suit your educational and schedule needs.

Activity Sessions

Details:

- 8-12 participants are required for each session, if the group is made up of minors 1 adult must be present per group (with no additional programming fees)
- 1-to-1.5-hour sessions
- Trained facilitators
- All necessary materials and equipment
- Any groups between 13-15 will have an additional charge per person
 - for \$60 activities an additional \$5 per additional participant
 - for \$150 activities an additional \$12.50 per additional participant
 - for \$170 activities an additional \$14 per additional participant

Our family-friendly pool area is fenced with a spacious baby pool, diving well, ADA lift and stocked concessions stand. A playground is conveniently located beside the pool parking lot.
